

***Praxis*[®] CASE (Core Academic Skills for Educators) Instructions**

You must either **have passing scores from the Praxis I** or **pass the *Praxis*[®] CASE** (also referred to as *Praxis*[®] Core) to be fully admitted to a teacher preparation program in the State of Alaska. The three tests (Reading, Writing, and Mathematics) may be taken individually or together (Combined Test).

The tests are designated as follows:

- 1. 5712 Core Academic Skills for Educators: Reading (Qualifying Test Score-156)**
- 2. 5722 Core Academic Skills for Educators: Writing (Qualifying Test Score-162)**
- 3. 5732 Core Academic Skills for Educators: Mathematics (Qualifying Test Score-150)**
- 4. 5751 Core Academic Skills for Educators: Combined Test**

If you are taking all three *Praxis*[®] CASE/Core Tests on the same date, please register for the 5751 Core Academic Skills for Educators: Combined Test.

Please view <http://www.ets.org/praxis/ak/> for an overview of the testing requirements; be aware that now the ONLY version of the Praxis is a computer-based test. After preparation for the tests and when you are ready to register, scroll down the webpage to the bottom and click “Register for a Test.” During this process you will be able to pull up the Test Center locations to identify the nearest testing center.

When you register for the *Praxis*[®] CASE/Core, be sure to designate UAS as a Score Recipient. In order for your scores to be reported to UAS, you will need to identify UAS as a score recipient on your registration form or during the registration process. To do this you will need to list “U of Alaska-SE” under Score Recipient and enter the code for UAS (4897). **If UAS does not receive your scores, you will need to contact ETS and pay a fee (about \$50) to have your scores re-issued.**

If you are taking the *Praxis*[®] CASE/Core outside the state of Alaska, be sure to designate the Alaskan Department of Education and Early Development as a Score Recipient. If you take the Praxis outside the state of Alaska your scores will not automatically be sent to this department. In order for Alaska’s teacher credentialing agency to receive your scores you must identify them as a score recipient (just like you must do for UAS to receive your scores). You will need to list “AK DEED” under Score Recipient and enter the code (7027). **If either UAS or the Alaska Dept. of Education does not receive your scores, you will need to contact ETS and pay a fee (about \$50) to have your scores re-issued.**

After your test date, your scores will be available to you via your online account (and your designated score recipients) in about 2-3 weeks.
