Liability Waivers

Three new liability waivers went out in the last month for the following UAS activities: Dive In Movie (students watch a movie on the big screen while in the local community swimming pool), Polar Plunge (jumping into the ocean from Auke Bay dock) and Skate Night (ice skating at the Treadwell Arena).

Student Activities and the Rec Center are trying out SMARTWAIVER, an online product that allows waivers to be uploaded to a computer where they can accept electronic signatures, sign waivers either ahead of time online or at a waiver kiosk at the event. After giving it a spin for a period of time, we will decide if it is a good fit for UAS and perhaps expand use to the academic departments. UAA and UAF are monitoring our evaluation with interest. Red Cross Shelter Exercise

Signage at Dock and Pavilion
