Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program

Student Application Procedures

To be approved for a TEACH Grant at the University of Alaska, a student must:

1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/> for the aid year for which the grant is sought.
2. Be admitted to a TEACH Grant eligible undergraduate or graduate program in the University of Alaska system (list available at http://www.uas.alaska.edu/financial_aid/types/grants/teachgrant.html. *If admitted to an undergraduate program, student must have at least Junior standing (60+ credits).*
3. Meet all U.S. Department of Education requirements for TEACH Grant eligibility; see <http://www.studentaid.ed.gov/PORTALSWebApp/students/english/TEACH.jsp>.
4. Meet with the TEACH Grant Advisor in the School of Education and complete the TEACH Grant Recommendation form found at: http://www.uas.alaska.edu/financial_aid/docs/TEACHGrantrecommendation.pdf. The School of Education will submit this form to the Financial Aid Office.
5. Submit the “Agreement to Serve” and TEACH Grant counseling” at <https://teach-ats.ed.gov/ats/index.action> for the aid year for which the grant is sought.

Once all required documentation has been received, the Financial Aid Office will review your application and notify you of your eligibility for the TEACH Grant and any further steps you may need to take.
