- c. A writing sample consisting of three parts:
 - statement of professional objectives
 - sample of academic, work-related or other writing
 - impromptu writing sample
- d. Letters of recommendation on specific forms (provided in application packet supplied by the Center for Teacher Education) form three (3) separate individuals.
- e. To be fully admitted to the program, applicants must take the Praxis I exam. To successfully graduate from the program, interns must pass all three sections of the Praxis I exam at State of Alaska approved levels.
- f. Documentation of successful work with children in an elementary or early childhood school setting
- g. A letter of support from the local school district administration.
