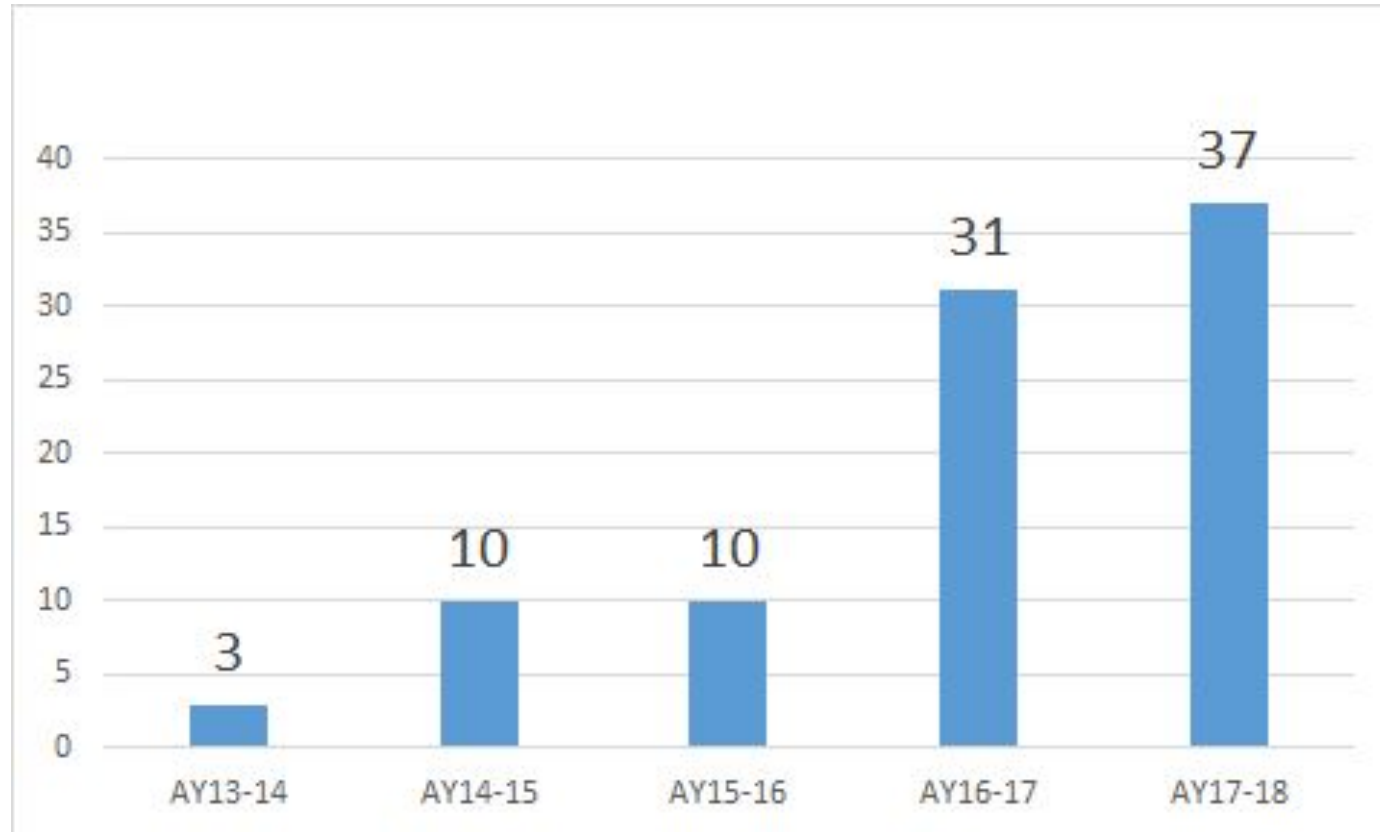
What is Title IX?

“No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex and gender, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activities receiving Federal financial assistance.”

2017 Student Climate Survey

- Conducted by the UAA Justice Center
- Systemwide survey
- Undergraduate students only
- Just over 700 students participated
- No UAS-specific data
- Baseline data for future surveys

2017 Student Climate Survey

- **Prevalence of Victimization**

- Sexual misconduct
- Sexual assault
- Dating violence
- Stalking

- **Protective Behaviors and Interventions**

- **Policy, Procedure & Prevention Training**

- **General Campus Climate**

Climate Survey: Prevalence of Victimization

Stalking: 11.7%

Sexual Misconduct: 9%

Dating Violence: 8.1%

Sexual Assault: 3.1%

General Campus Climate

92% *I feel safe on my campus.*

88% *I am happy to be at this university.*

91% *I feel valued in the learning environment.*

86% *Faculty are generally concerned about
my welfare.*

Biggest Climate Survey Takeaways

- Stalking/harassment behaviors are underreported at UAS
- 84% of UAS reports come through a faculty or staff member, however, survey results indicate victims most likely disclose to a close friend (not a roommate)
