

The University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation/completion status of students who enrolled during the 2002-2003 school year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed.

During the fall semester of 2002, 140 first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking Undergraduate students entered UAS. After 6 years (as of August 31, 2008) 14% of these students had graduated from our institution or completed their programs. During this same six-year period, 11% of the 140 students transferred to other institutions of higher learning before completing their UAS programs.

For degree-seeking students who started in the Fall terms of 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002, an average of 17% completed their programs within 150% of normal completion time; an average of 22% transferred to other institutions before completing their UAS programs.
