



# Weapons Storage Agreement

Office of Residence Life, 2007-08

**The possession of concealed handguns is strictly prohibited on University premises. The possession of firearms, explosives, and/or prohibited weapons is also prohibited by authority of the University of Alaska Board of Regents pursuant to A.S. 14.40.170 and 18.65.755 except as expressly authorized by University Regulation.**

The Office of Residence Life will provide secured weapons storage on a first-come, first-served basis to residents of UAS student housing subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Weapons storage will not be offered to any students who have had weapons violations in the past year, or those who have had any felony or misdemeanor charges related to illegal weapons possession or use. Weapons should be owned by the students wishing to store them.
2. All weapons must be approved by the Residence Life Manager before being stored in housing; approved weapons must be stored immediately in the secured weapons facility within a weapons locker, and the student must provide his or her own key-operated padlock as approved by the RLM. Weapons must be registered with the department before they will be accepted into storage. At no time will students be permitted to keep weapons in their own possession, including in personal vehicles, when on university property.
3. Residents are expected to abide by the UAS Residence Life Weapons Policy in the Residence Life Handbook, the UAS Student Handbook, and any applicable state or federal laws.
4. Each time a student wishes to check out his/her weapon from secured storage, a weapons checkout form must be completed, and checkout must be arranged with a professional staff member of the department or with the Security Officer. Students will be guaranteed access solely with a checkout appointment scheduled at least 24 hours in advance, though reasonable access will be granted with fewer than 24 hours advanced notice when possible. Once checked out, the weapons must be removed IMMEDIATELY from campus by the student until which point the student returns to campus to check in the weapon, immediately upon his/her arrival. Access will not be given to anyone but the owner/student who registered the weapon.
5. This agreement is revocable at any time at the discretion of the Residence Life Manager or the Director of Auxiliary Services; due process and written notice will be provided.
6. A staff member of the department reserves the right to deny access to students whom he or she deems unfit to manage their weapon, such as in states of inebriation or agitation. The university also reserves the right to turn over weapons to the police if the weapons are abandoned, if the agreement has been violated, or if the student has had significant conduct issues addressed through the judiciary process.
7. If a weapon is found at any time on university premises outside of secured storage, including weapons that have been registered with the department, the weapon(s) may be confiscated, judiciary action will follow (as stipulated in the Residence Life Handbook), and legal action may also be taken by the university.
8. The university accepts no responsibility for the conditions of the weapons kept in secured storage. Care and maintenance of weapons is solely the responsibility of the owner, and accommodations for weapon upkeep is outlined in the Residence Life Handbook. Owners store weapons on campus at their own risk. Damages or losses caused by water damage, fire, or other such events will not be reimbursed by UAS.

I understand and agree to abide by the terms and conditions as stated above for the use and storage of secured weapons at the University of Alaska Southeast. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the University of Alaska Southeast and/or representatives thereof for any liability resulting from the use of weapons storage.
