

40-HOUR ASBESTOS ABATEMENT CERTIFICATION

8-HOUR ASBESTOS ABATEMENT REFRESHER

Worker Certification

Workers will be certified for one year by the Alaska Department of Labor and approved to work in the asbestos abatement industry.

Course Content

The goal for the student is to gain knowledge about asbestos abatement work and the regulatory requirements. Active participation in class, effective demonstrations of safe work practices during the hands-on practicum, and a passing grade on the written examination will allow the student to successfully apply for their Certificate of Fitness (COF) asbestos card through the State of Alaska, Department of Labor. Instruction on the COF application process is detailed in the course content.

Note: The State of Alaska Department of Labor will issue the state asbestos card after receiving the application and fee from you. The COF fee must be received by the Department of Labor within 30 days of course completion. If you exceed this payment deadline, your application fee will not be accepted and you will be required to take this training class again and submit the fee within the required timeframe in order to receive your state asbestos card. Certification fee is payable to the State of Alaska, P.O. Box 107022, Anchorage, Alaska 99510-7022.

Refresher Certification

This refresher course satisfies AHERA Worker and Supervisor requirements. Current card holders must take the 8-hour refresher course before the annual anniversary date and receive their current asbestos card from DOL in order to continue working in the field.

The goal for the student in this one-day class is to review the information about asbestos abatement work obtained from the initial training course and obtain up-to-date information about asbestos abatement operations. They will then qualify for a renewal. Students attending this course MUST bring their current state asbestos card to class for visual verification by the instructor or they will not be able to take the class.

Note: The State of Alaska Department of Labor will issue the state asbestos card after receiving the application and fee from you. The COF fee must be received by the Department of Labor within 30 days of course completion.
