

# **Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association Seasonal/Intern Employment Opportunities**

Below is a partial list of available seasonal opportunities with CIAA in 2016.

## **All Positions**

- CIAA will provide lodging and food during the length of employment.
- Lodging facilities will vary pending on location from weather ports to bunkhouse.
- The successful employee is responsible for all travel costs associated with getting to the place of hire. The place of hire varies by project location and may be Kenai, Moose Pass or Homer, Alaska. CIAA will pay for the travel costs associated with getting from the place of hire to the project location. If flying, CIAA recommends purchasing flexible tickets since length of employment is dependent on strength of returns and weather conditions.
