1. UNAC agreement has been reached and will go before the Legislature for approval of supplemental budget in January. If the Legislature approves, Faculty will receive 3% increase for FY23 and staff will receive an additional 1%. FY24 will see a 2.75% increase, and then 2.5% in FY25.
