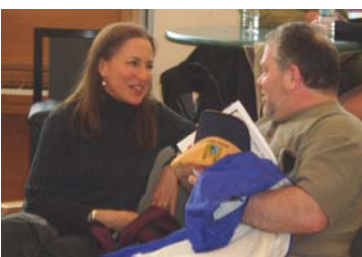

Turn in Tutor Request forms EARLY! Receiving your tutor request before your course starts or in

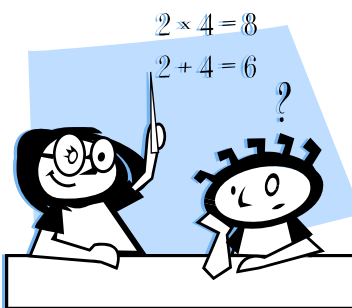
May (whichever comes first) helps you find a tutor more quickly. Because staffing in the summer is noticeably limited, we encourage you even more strenuously
