MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
SOUTHEAST REGIONAL RESOURCE CENTER
And
UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA SOUTHEAST

The purpose of this agreement between University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) and Southeast Regional Resource Center (SERRC) is to provide collaboration and support for educational workshops, programs, vocational training and classes that benefit students and teachers of Alaska (clients). UAS and SERRC share a commitment to jointly participate in the following activities:

Referral: The agencies agree to provide clients with information and access to informational, educational and career exploration programs of UAS and SERRC.

Collaboration: The staffs of both agencies agree to collaborate and coordinate educational programs, workshops, and classes for Alaskan students and teachers so that clients have the opportunity and support necessary to access training suitable for their needs.

Planning and Coordination: The staff of both agencies agrees to meet at least semi-annually to discuss strategies for working together to provide for the educational options and training that assists Alaskan teachers to successfully educate their students and assists Alaskan students to achieve educational goals and to enter Alaska's high growth industry workforce.

Training: The agencies agree to share information about education and training opportunities available to clients and to be available as a mutual resource in applicable areas. When offering teacher training that consists of twelve and a half hours or more of direct contact time, SERRC will submit a course proposal to the UAS Professional Education Center, in order for teachers to earn professional development credit. Workshops and other extended trainings designed for high school-age participants that include students who are at least sixteen years old, and that contain at least twelve and a half hours of direct contact time, will offer lower division credit (ED193) through submission of a course proposal with the UAS Professional Education Center.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF AGREEMENT: This agreement shall be in effect from April 2009 until such time that the parties to the Agreement agree that it should be changed or terminated.
