

**FY19 MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**  
**University of Alaska Southeast and the Juneau Arts & Humanities Council**

The University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) and Juneau Arts & Humanities Council (JAHC) agree to collaborate on a variety of arts and cultural community events, recognizing that each entity strengthens the programs of the other.

UAS will:

- Arrange the UAS tour for the Poetry Out Loud competitors in March 2019, coordinating between the Student Services staff and the staff of JAHC.
- Support JAHC with a \$5,000 cash contribution.
- Recruit and help select UAS representatives (1 student & 1 staff) to the JAHC Board of Trustees.

JAHC will:

- List UAS as a season sponsor on all printed publicity, on the web site, in the JACC, and link directly from the web to UAS. This is considered a \$5000 cash value and includes 4 complimentary premium concert tickets and 4 Flash Zone Saturday Wearable Art seats (a table), which may be used for fundraising auctions, or however best serves the purposes of the University.
- Provide \$5 ticket prices to all Performing Arts and Culture Concerts for UAS students.
- Include the UAS Art Department Juried Art Show in the annual JAH C Gallery exhibits in April.
- Provide exhibit space for UAS students and faculty as needed.
- Collaborate with UAS, Juneau Jazz & Classics, and the Juneau School District to coordinate the non-profit and community participation for Community Day on Campus held annually in May.
- Collaborate on a college tour visit by Poetry Out Loud state finalists in March through the campus recruitment / admissions office.
- Offer Teaching Artist Training workshops, through which participants can earn one professional development credit.
- Assist in promoting UAS classes, particularly the art and creative writing classes, and the UAS Arts publication, Tidal Echoes.
- Assist in promoting Evening at Egan through radio, and online calendaring.
- Collaborate on the planning for the signature summertime event, tentatively called Teacher as Artist/Artist as Teacher.
- Collaborate as a partner with UAS and the Juneau School District on the Margaret A. Cargill Artful Teaching grant work.
- Provide intern opportunities in the arts as needed.
- Bring Holiday Pops to campus in December, to encourage community use of the campus.
- Provide a representative to serve on the UAS Juneau Campus Advisory Council, preferably the Executive Director.

Both organizations agree to support and promote the work each does for the benefit of the community of Juneau.
