

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA SOUTHEAST (UAS) AND JUNEAU SCHOOL DISTRICT (JSD)**

PURPOSE:

The Juneau School District agrees to provide programs that strive to increase the Alaska Native student graduation rate and prepare Alaska Native Students for a successful transition to higher education programs. The programs will involve jointly coordinated sessions on the UAS campus, among other activities. The program at Juneau-Douglas High School (JDHS) is known as the *Early Scholars Program*. At Thunder Mountain High School (TMHS), the funds will be used to help increase Alaska Native student participation in the Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) program.

TERMS:

To assist in defraying the costs of these programs, UAS will pay JSD up to \$7500 in FY19 (i.e., July 2018-June 2018) for tuition and fees at UAS (i.e. dual enrollment), contractual services, professional development, supplies and materials. The amount of \$3750 each is allocated to the Early Scholars Program at JDHS and the AVID program at TMHS. Payment will be made upon receipt of an invoice from JSD. All invoices MUST be received before June 1, 2019. Payment may be denied for invoices received after June 1. UAS reserves the right to reallocate and/or use unexpended and unencumbered funds after June 1. Each program will provide a year-end report to UAS that includes demographics, class standing, and contact information of the students who participated. An itemized budget will also be provided from each school.

UAS will provide faculty and classroom space to conduct the agreed upon on-campus activities.

Either party may terminate this agreement at any time with 30 days written notice.

This agreement will be in effect July 1, 2018 until June 1, 2019.


